2024-25 Dual Enrollment

In the Dual Enrollment program, students may take courses that meet requirements for high school graduation while earning college credit at Tidewater Community College (TCC). Grades are awarded according to the policies of the college and credits earned for the courses taken can be transferred to other public colleges in Virginia. Students are responsible for verifying the college credit for successful completion of any course with the colleges and universities they choose to attend.

Initial Process

- Discuss your interest in Dual Enrollment with your parent/guardian and high school counselor as you begin planning your class schedule for your junior and senior year.
- Complete the TCC online application for admission. If you get stuck, contact the TCC New Student Support Team at 757-822-7172 or vbwelcome@tcc.edu
- Complete the Dual Enrollment login. Students will have to set up an account on this system instead of completing the DE application.

Tuition Costs

The student is responsible for costs associated with the courses (i.e., tuition, fees). The fees are set by the college. Tuition is required for all courses. Tuition is paid at the time of registration, not at the time of application. The cost is \$45 per credit hour and collected through VBCPS (RevTrak).
